





Day 7 - Dürnstein - Krems

- As part of the UNESCO World Heritage-listed landscape since 2001, it is one of Austria's most important Benedictine abbeys and attracts visitors from all over the world.
- Built in 1083, it continues to serve as a spiritual center in the heart of Lower Austria and is run by a community of about 45 monks.






Day 10 - Budapest




