
#### Day 2 MOHACS - PECS - VILLANY

#### **VUKOVAR, CROATIA - NOVI SAD, SERBIA**





- Inside, you'll be treated to a fascinating historical reenactment. The ship departs early afternoon. (B,L,D)












#### Day 7 GIURGIU - BUCHAREST, ROMANIA - ROUSSE, BULGARIA






