



Day 4 - Dürnstein - Krems

- Today, you can choose to hike the ruins of Dürnstein Castle, offering delightful panoramic views of the surrounding medieval villages. Afterwards, we will sail through the fascinating UNESCO World Heritage-listed Wachau Valley and on to Krems.
- Or take guided bike tour from Dürnstein to Krems, passing terraced vineyards, castles and ruins along the way
- This afternoon, enjoy a guided tour of Göttweig Abbey ,overlooking the Wachau from a hill covered by vineyards and forests,. As part of the UNESCO World Heritage landscape since 2001, it is one of Austria's most important Benedictine abbeys and attracts visitors from all over the world. Built in 1083, it continues to serve as a spiritual center in the heart of Lower Austria and is run by a community of about 45 monks. Visible from great distance, the abbey provides epic panoramas when you visit.






Day 7 - Budapest


