- * Ground transfers are included with Viking Air purchase.


Day 2 Budapest

- Rejoin your ship in Visegrád for lunch as we cruise along the scenic Danube River.
- Enjoy a midafternoon Viennese coffee workshop, complete with apple strudel. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)


Day 2 Shore Excursions

- We are docked here overnight. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 4 Shore Excursions

- <u>Behind the Scenes at the Lipizzaner Stallions</u>—step backstage at the elegant Spanish Riding School, home to the world-famous Lipizzaner stallions.
- Mozart & Strauss Concert—the classical music never stops in Vienna, as you will hear firsthand during this special concert.
- <u>Alma Deutscher plays Mozart & Strauss</u>—privileged access-- Delight in an enchanting evening of music with a privileged access performance led by the renowned Alma Deutscher.
- <u>Picturesque Bratislava</u>--Get acquainted with the Slovakian capital, a vibrant and relaxed cultural center.
- Viennese Waltz & Mozart--Don your dancing shoes as you learn the steps of the Viennese waltz and visit Mozart's Vienna apartment

Day 5 Krems

- After breakfast, disembark in Krems and set off for Göttweig, a working Benedictine abbey that owns many of the vineyards along the Danube.
- See the splendid ceiling fresco in its imperial stairwell, one of the largest in the world. Visit the abbey church, a masterpiece of baroque architecture.
- Alternately, you may instead choose to explore your environs by bicycle, enjoying a ride along a riverside bike path considered one of Europe's most scenic.
- Afterward, rejoin your ship and cruise leisurely through the captivating Wachau Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Taste some local Austrian specialties during lunch on board, taking in views of attractive towns and castle ruins along the way.
- (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 5 Shore Excursions

- <u>Göttweig Abbey</u>—included--Experience a Benedictine abbey where monks work and worship during an exclusive visit to Göttweig Abbey.
- <u>Wachau Valley by Bicycle</u>-- Follow the flat bicycle trails along the scenic Danube to Dürnstein on an electric bike, or e-bike.
- Göttweig Abbey with Apricot Dumpling Demonstration -- Enjoy an exclusive visit to historic Göttweig Abbey before learning how to make tasty apricot dumplings.





Day 6 Passau

Arrive this morning in Passau, at the confluence of the Inn, Ilz and Danube Rivers.

Your guided walk along the town's narrow streets takes you through Old Town and past traditional patrician houses. See the New Bishop's Residence and view the impressive baroque St. Stephen's Cathedral.

Enjoy lunch on board your ship and return to the city for further exploration on your own before departing.

Alternately, you may instead journey into the countryside on an optional excursion to a local farm where you will have the opportunity to join a festive Bavarian party, experiencing traditional German music and food and tasting locally brewed beer.

Or, you may choose a full-day optional excursion to explore glorious Salzburg; visit the Italianate Old Town, see settings from the film *The Sound of Music* and enjoy lunch at Austria's oldest restaurant.

- <u>Passau Walking Tour</u>—included--Explore the Italianate-style streets of Passau, where three European rivers have converged to shape a distinctive city.
- <u>Salzburg Highlights</u>--Spend the day in picturesque Salzburg, setting of the beloved film *The Sound of Music* and the birthplace of Mozart.
- <u>Bavarian Beerfest</u>--Participate in a festive Oktoberfest-style celebration in a stunning rural setting.
- <u>Bavaria by E-Bike</u>--Escape Passau as you pedal along the Inn River, enjoying unspoiled nature and pastoral landscapes along the water.
- <u>Hike the Passau Hills</u>--Take in Passau's sublime setting at the confluence of three rivers from the best vantage points in the city.
- <u>Fairy-Tale Neuschwanstein Castle by Plane</u>--See the famous fairy-tale castle that inspired Walt Disney and enjoy a flight over the surrounding countryside.
- <u>Flightseeing over Passau</u>--Take flight on a private charter over the stunning lakes, rivers and mountains of Germany and Austria.



Day 7 Regensburg

- After breakfast, meet your local guide for a walking tour through the scenic town of Regensburg, considered one of Europe's best preserved medieval cities.
- See one of the largest groupings of 13th- and 14th-century church spires, towers and patrician houses north of the Alps. You also encounter the 12th-century Old Stone Bridge, St. Peter's Cathedral and several idyllic courtyards.
- Take time to stroll the streets, shop or visit Germany's oldest restaurant, the Alte Würstküche. Lunch is served on board your ship.
- This afternoon, take an optional excursion to visit Weltenburg Abbey* and experience a short cruise through a stunning mountain pass, one of the most breathtakingly scenic bends in the Danube Narrows.
- Alternately, you may choose a full-day optional excursion to see the highlights of the grand city of Munich or a full-day optional excursion to Nuremberg, one of Germany's most renowned and intriguing cities.

- * Weltenburg Abbey tour is available from May–October only.

- Regensburg Walking Tour—included-Witness a true medieval city untouched by World War II bombing and rich in architectural splendor.

- Regensburg Jewish Walking Tour--Discover the Jewish heritage of Regensburg during a walking tour of this historic city.
- Munich Highlights--See the cultural and historic highlights of one of Germany's most relaxed cities, beautifully set near the foothills of the Alps during a panoramic tour.
- <u>Microbreweries of Bavaria</u>--Sample a selection of Bavaria's best-loved brews, accompanied by classic biergarten fare.
- <u>Historic Nuremberg</u>--Tour one of Germany's most renowned and intriguing cities on this full-day excursion.




