
Day 1 - Basel




Day 4 - Ludwigshafen - Heidelberg



- Journey by cable car to Ehrenbreitstein Fortress, offering exceptional views of the surrounding area from its hilltop position.






Day 6 - Cologne

- As part of your EmeraldPLUS program, enjoy a fantastic cooking demo and have a glimpse behind the scenes of this fantastic place.


