
- This morning you'll visit the iconic Keukenhof Gardens, boasting 32 hectares of spring-flowering bulbs.







Day 3 - Cologne


Day 4 - Koblenz






Day 5 - Ludwigshafen – Schwetzingen

- Schwetzingen Palace is famous for the beauty and harmony of its gardens.
- Remarkably, the original design survives to this day.
- Besides the palace interior, you will also visit the Palace Gardens, a cultural heritage site of European significance with more than 100 sculptures scattered throughout this picture-perfect landscape.
- Alternatively, you can embark on an active journey to the quaint wellness town of Bad-Dürkheim for a hike through the beautiful vineyards.
